

The Wesley City Council met in special session, April 11, 2017 in council chambers. Mayor Duane Larson called the 6:30 pm meeting to order. Roll call was answered by council members Neuroth, Golwitzer, Studer, and Riggert arrived at 6:38 pm. Bills was absent. Others present, Ludwig, Ricke, and Wingert.

The council was informed about the problems with the storm drainage. Studer made a motion to approve the blockage to be repaired, Golwitzer seconded the motion. Riggert abstained from vote due to missing discussion.

A discussion was talked about where Becker Construction was supposed to start working on main street sidewalks. The council made the decision to start on the 200th block of main street on the north side, after they talk to The Community Center on what events will be coming up to get a start date.

Ragbrai was discussed as well in this meeting and the council decided to set the vendor fees for that day. Motion made to approve fees by Golwitzer and seconded by Studer, all ayes. A new ordinance will be introduced at the May 8th council meeting to coordinate these changes. The fees will be as follows:

The council talked about the street repairs that needed to be made before Ragbrai. Council will get more bids back for the May 8th meeting and will make a decision then.
