Youngwirth, 110 votes; Write-in: Theresa Grady, 26 votes; Scattered 9 votes. Joella Leider & Steven M. Youngwirth duly elected for the office of Wesley City Council at Large for the term of 4 years.

Ayes: Studer, Golwitzer and Neuroth: Motion passed to hire Pool Tech for our pool repairs. Riggert and Bills sustained from the vote.

The City received two bids for the removal of the willow tree west of City Hall. Golwitzer made a motion to go with AJ's Service, seconded by Riggert. All ayes.

A motion was approved by Neuroth and seconded by Golwitzer to have Nuncio's Construction & Steinman to fix City Halls North side building. All Ayes.

The First Reading of Ordinance No. 154: An Ordinance Amending The Code of Ordinances of the City of Wesley, Iowa, By Amending Provisions Pertaining to Fireworks was edited and tabled till next meeting.

The First Reading of Ordinance No. 155: Dog License Required was passed with motion from Riggert and Seconded by Bills. Ayes: Golwitzer, Studer and Neuroth. Golwitzer made a motion to waive 2nd and 3rd readings and seconded by Riggert. Effective January 1st.

The meeting adorned at 7:50 PM. A motion was made by Golwitzer and seconded by Studer. All ayes. The next meeting is scheduled for January 8th.
