A motion by Riggert was made to hire North Iowa Mechanical to fix air conditioner and furnace for the library and seconded by Leider. All Ayes.

Council woman Riggert made a motion to keep our membership with Air Med and seconded by Youngwirth. All Ayes.

Councilman Neuroth made a motion to set miscellaneous garbage fees as;
Large bulky items: items that cannot be broken down to fit in standard (35-gallon maximum) garbage container or bag such as; chair, couch mattress, rugs/carpet, and shelving- Fee: \$15.00 for the first item; \$5.00 for each additional item per pickup
Electronics: computers, televisions, VCRs, printers, etc. -\$30.00 per electronic
Appliances: refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, air conditioners, microwaves, water heaters, etc. -\$30.00 per
