Motion by Bills, seconded by Neuroth to approve resolution 18-11 a resolution establishing an employee clothing allowance policy for employees of the City of Wesley passed with 3 votes ayes by Bills, Youngwirth and Neuroth. Nays Riggert as it did not have a dress code requirement and Leider abstaining from vote.

Kim Neuroth spoke on behalf of the Community Club asking the council for a fridge in the new shelter house, a new welcome to Wesley sign and funds for the 150<sup>th</sup> celebration in 2022. Leider made a motion to look for a good used fridge for the shelter house, seconded by Neuroth. All ayes. Bills made a motion to start looking into getting a new welcome to Wesley sign for town and asking other organizations in town to be a part of it as well, seconded by Neuroth. All ayes.
