## SPEED REGULATIONS

63.02 STATE CODE SPEED LIMITS. The following speed limits are established in Section 321.285 of the Code of Iowa and any speed in excess thereof is unlawful unless specifically designated otherwise in this chapter as a special speed zone.

1. Business District - 20 miles per hour.
2. Residence or School District - 25 miles per hour.
3. Suburban District - 45 miles per hour.

63.03 PARKS, CEMETERIES, AND PARKING LOTS. A speed in excess of 15 miles per hour in any public park, cemetery, or parking lot, unless specifically designated otherwise in this chapter, is unlawful. (Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.236[5])

## DOGS

Please be aware that **ALL DOGS MUST** be leashed under the City Code Requirements (55.18) If Dogs are picked up and unlicensed by the City of Wesley, your dog will be impounded (57.09).

55.18 LEASH REQUIRED. Any person owning a dog shall confine the same from running at large. It is the duty of every person owning a dog to:

1. Confine the dog by good and sufficient means; or
2. Cause the dog to be under the control of a person competent to restrain and control the dog, either by leash, cord, chain, or other similar restraint of sufficient strength, and not more than six feet in length; or
3. Properly restrain in a motor vehicle or keep the dog in a veterinary hospital or registered kennel. A muzzled dog shall not be deemed to have been restrained unless the above conditions are also met.

57.09 KENNEL DOGS.

1. Any unlicensed dog found at large in violation of this chapter shall be seized and impounded.
  2. When an unlicensed dog has been apprehended and impounded written notice shall be provided to the owner within two (2) days after impoundment, if the owner's name and current address can reasonably be determined by accessing a tag or other device that is on for part of the animal. Impounded unlicensed dogs may be recovered by the owner by payment of the license fee, delinquency fee, impounding costs and if an unvaccinated dog by having it immediately vaccinated. If the owner fails to redeem the dog within seven (7) days from the date that the notice is mailed or if the owner cannot be located within seven (7) days, the dog shall be disposed of in accordance with law or destroyed by euthanasia.
  3. Impounding fees are twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for the first day and ten (\$10.00) dollars per day thereafter.

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF WESLEY**

As electors of the City of Wesley, you are hereby notified that a vacancy in the office of Mayor existed on August 17, 2021 due to the resignation of Vahn Schumacher. The Council intends to fill the vacancy by appointment. The appointment shall be for the period until the next regular city election and shall be made within sixty (60) days after the vacancy occurs. The electors of the city have the right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by a special election. The Council may make the appointment to fill the vacancy after this notice is published or after the vacancy occurs, whichever is later. However, if within fourteen (14) days after publication of this notice or within fourteen (14) days after the appointment is made, whichever is later, there is filed with the city clerk a petition which requests a special election to fill the vacancy, an appointment to fill the vacancy is temporary and the council shall call a special election to fill the vacancy permanently for the remaining balance of the unexpired term. The Council intends to fill the vacancy at the regular scheduled for meeting 6:30 p.m. on Monday, September 13, 2021.
